

2019 BPCC Homecoming Court Election

An election is held each fall to select a Homecoming Court to be presented at the Homecoming basketball game which is held during the spring semester. The court consists of a King and Queen, three Sophomore Maids (30 credit hours or more) and three Freshman Maids (29 credit hours or less). The sophomore candidate receiving the highest number of votes serves as the Queen.

Qualifications

All Homecoming Court nominees must meet the following qualifications:

- Plan to attend BPCC next spring semester
 - Have and maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA or higher through fall semester
 - Be a full-time student in good standing enrolled in 12 hours or more
 - Be nominated by a student organization, academic department or faculty/staff member
