JOHN RENNIE - HEAD COACH / ATHLETIC DIRECTOR



After finishing 8-21 and missing out on postseason play in 2016-17, coach John Rennie and his team have high hopes for a return to success on the hardwood in 2017-18.

In launching the women's basketball program at BPCC, Rennie has led the Lady Cavaliers to a 55-65 (.458) record through four seasons as a college coach, after coaching most of the previous 20 years as an AAU coach in the Shreveport-Bossier area. His former players include many who advanced to play collegiately as well as two at the WNBA level.

As a player at the now defunct Trinity Heights Christian Academy, Rennie helped lead his high school team to three state championships while earning All-State, All-District and All-City honors.

He is also the founder of HoopKids Basketball, an enrichment program that teaches basic basketball skills to preschoolers while further developing their gross motor skills. Operating this program has allowed him the privilege to watch hundreds of pre-school children grow and develop basic coordination skills while learning about the great game of basketball.

Rennie, who also serves as the Athletic Director at BPCC, resides in Benton, La., with his beautiful wife, Melissa and his children, Caden (14) and Claire (11) Cox.

Rennie's thoughts on the 2016-2017 season:

"We're playing a very difficult schedule again this year," said Lady Cavaliers head coach John Rennie, who begins his fifth season at BPCC. "I looked at the preseason national rankings, and we have three of the top six on our schedule this year, including two-time defending national champion Gulf Coast State, as well as two-time national runner-up and conference opponent Trinity Valley."

"We have the depth to matchup better and compete for 40 minutes this year," said Rennie. "Our sophomores have made a lot of progress over the last year. Then, with the newcomers we have added we feel we should be able to return to the regional tournament. It definitely wasn't enjoyable not playing postseason basketball last year."

ALICE ROBINSON - ASSISTANT COACH



Alice Robinson is in her second year as an assistant coach at Bossier Parish Community College. A Bossier City native, Robinson returns home after spending two seasons as a student assistant coach at Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas.

Robinson played in 63 games over two seasons for the Cardinals from 2012-14, scoring 264 points and grabbing 356 rebounds. She helped lead the Cardinals to the postseason in both years at Lamar, advancing to the second round of the WBI in 2013 and qualifying for the WNIT in 2014.

As a senior, she averaged 3.8 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. Had career highs of 13 points and 13 rebounds against Our Lady of the Lake. Tied her career high with 13 points in a Southland Conference Tournament semifinal game versus Northwestern State. She was named to the Southland Conference Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

Prior to Lamar, Robinson played two seasons for Trinity Valley Community College. She helped lead the TVCC Cardinals to the NJCAA National Title and an undefeated 36-0 record as a sophomore. Robinson averaged 5.4 points and 7.9 points per game as a sophomore at Trinity Valley.

Played for Aaron Megee at Parkway High School, where she earned honorable mention all-state honors as a senior year. Parkway retired her uniform number in 2015. She also competed in track and field in high school, finishing fifth in the state in the shot put as a senior.

Robinson holds an associate's degree from Trinity Valley, a bachelor's in general studies as well as a master's degree in criminal justice from Lamar.

- With its 90-68 win over Coastal Bend, BPCC is now 2-3 in Region XIV openers
- It was the second straight road win for the Lady Cavs, a first since the 2015-16 season

- Lady Cavs snapped a four-game losing skid with its 79-76 win over Hill

LADY CAVS CLOBBER COUGARS

With the scored tied at 37 at halftime, the BPCC Lady Cavaliers erupted for 53 second half points, including an incredible 38 in the fourth quarter, to capture a convincing 90-68 win over the Coastal Bend Cougars.

BPCC CLIMBS OVER HILL

The BPCC Lady Cavaliers avenged an earlier season loss to Hill College with a 79-76 win over the Lady Rebels on the road in Hillsboro, Texas.

Down by 12 points at the start of the fourth quarter, BPCC outscored Hill 29-14 in the final frame capture the victory.

Ashlyn Jacobs scored a game-high 23 points while Tyra Kidd and Savannah Thomas added 16 and 13 points, respectively.

The win snapped BPCC's four-game losing skid. It was also the first win for the Lady Cavaliers over the Lady Rebels in the program's five-year history.

LADY CAVS SPLIT TWO GAMES AT BRCC CLASSIC

BATON ROUGE - The Bossier Parish Community College Lady Cavaliers basketball team split a pair of games here this past weekend at the Baton Rouge Community College Classic. BPCC defeated Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College, 62-49, on Friday, Nov. 3, then lost a heartbreaker, 84-82, to Clarendon College Saturday, Nov. 4. Both games were played at the Bonne Sante Wellness Center on BRCC's main campus.

In a morning matchup between two evenly-matched teams, the BPCC Lady Cavs couldn't overcome the tremendous three-point

shooting of the Clarendon Lady Bulldogs. BPCC had a better field goal percentage and more rebounds than Clarendon, but the Lady Bulldogs shot 48 percent (15-of-31) from beyond the arc and 94 percent (17-of-180) from the free throw line.

"Any time you lose it's tough," said BPCC coach John Rennie. "We really defended them pretty well. They just shot the ball extremely well. Most of those makes were contested or from deep. Sometimes they go in, sometimes they don't. Today the fell for them. Overall, I'm pleased with the way we came out and competed this weekend."

Ashlyn Jacobs scored a career-high 30 points to lead BPCC to a season-opening 62-49 win over Mississippi Gulf Coast CC. The sophomore guard from Mansfield, La. enjoyed a fine shooting night as she finished 11-of-17 from the floor and 6-of-10 from the free throw line. Jacobs was the only Lady Cavalier to score in double figures.

2017-18 SEASON SCHEDULE & OUTLOOK

The Lady Cavaliers are coming off an 8-21 season in 2016-17, the first losing campaign since 2013-14, the program's inaugural season. BPCC has 30 regular season playing dates scheduled, including 13 home games, beginning Nov. 3rd and 4th with two games at Baton Rouge Community College. BPCC had three preseason scrimmages beginning with the Frisco Showcase on Oct. 14 in Frisco, Texas.

"We're playing a very difficult schedule again this year," said Lady Cavaliers head coach John Rennie, who begins his fifth season at BPCC. "We play the two-time defending national champions in Gulf Coast State, and Trinity Valley, who is in our region, is the two-time runners-up."

The Lady Cavs return four players and two starters from last year's team. Sophomores Ashlyn Jacobs (5-3, G, Mansfield, La.), Brandy Harris (5-6, G, Benton, La.), Tyra Kidd (5-10, C, Bossier City, La.) and Savannah Thomas (5-10, F, Shreveport, La.) played in all 29 of BPCC's games last year. Jacobs led the team in scoring in 2016-17 averaging 17.4 points per game, while Kidd and Harris chipped in with 5.5 and 4.5 points per game, respectively. Thomas averaged 8.2 points per game, which was third highest on the team, but was tops on the team in rebounds per game with a 5.3 average.

Rennie cites sophomore Damilola Balogun (6-0, F/C, Lagos, Nigeria) and freshman Monette Bolden (5-6, G, Erath, La.) as two of his top seven newcomers.

"We have the depth to matchup better and compete for 40 minutes this year," said Rennie. "Our sophomores have made a lot of progress over the last year. Then, with the newcomers we have added we should be able to return to the regional tournament. It wasn't enjoyable not playing postseason basketball last year."
