JOHN RENNIE - HEAD COACH / ATHLETIC DIRECTOR



After finishing 8-21 and missing out on postseason play in 2016-17, coach John Rennie and his team have high hopes for a return to success on the hardwood in 2017-18.

In launching the women's basketball program at BPCC, Rennie has led the Lady Cavaliers to a 55-65 (.458) record through four seasons as a college coach, after coaching most of the previous 20 years as an AAU coach in the Shreveport-Bossier area. His former players include many who advanced to play collegiately as well as two at the WNBA level.

As a player at the now defunct Trinity Heights Christian Academy, Rennie helped lead his high school team to three state championships while earning All-State, All-District and All-City honors.

He is also the founder of HoopKids Basketball, an enrichment program that teaches basic basketball skills to preschoolers while further developing their gross motor skills. Operating this program has allowed him the privilege to watch hundreds of pre-school children grow and develop basic coordination skills while learning about the great game of basketball.

Rennie, who also serves as the Athletic Director at BPCC, resides in Benton, La., with his beautiful wife, Melissa and his children, Caden (14) and Claire (11) Cox.

Rennie's thoughts on the 2016-2017 season:

"We're playing a very difficult schedule again this year," said Lady Cavaliers head coach John Rennie, who begins his fifth season at BPCC. "I looked at the preseason national rankings, and we have three of the top six on our schedule this year, including two-time defending national champion Gulf Coast State, as well as two-time national runner-up and conference opponent Trinity Valley."

"We have the depth to matchup better and compete for 40 minutes this year," said Rennie. "Our sophomores have made a lot of progress over the last year. Then, with the newcomers we have added we feel we should be able to return to the regional tournament. It definitely wasn't enjoyable not playing postseason basketball last year."

ALICE ROBINSON - ASSISTANT COACH



Alice Robinson is in her second year as an assistant coach at Bossier Parish Community College. A Bossier City native, Robinson returns home after spending two seasons as a student assistant coach at Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas.

Robinson played in 63 games over two seasons for the Cardinals from 2012-14, scoring 264 points and grabbing 356 rebounds. She helped lead the Cardinals to the postseason in both years at Lamar, advancing to the second round of the WBI in 2013 and qualifying for the WNIT in 2014.

As a senior, she averaged 3.8 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. Had career highs of 13 points and 13 rebounds against Our Lady of the Lake. Tied her career high with 13 points in a Southland Conference Tournament semifinal game versus Northwestern State. She was named to the Southland Conference Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

Prior to Lamar, Robinson played two seasons for Trinity Valley Community College. She helped lead the TVCC Cardinals to the NJCAA National Title and an undefeated 36-0 record as a sophomore. Robinson averaged 5.4 points and 7.9 points per game as a sophomore at Trinity Valley.

Robinson played for Aaron Megee at Parkway High School, where she earned honorable mention all-state honors as a senior. Parkway retired her uniform number in 2015. She also competed in track and field in high school, finishing fifth in the state in the shot put as a senior.

She holds an associate's degree from Trinity Valley, a bachelor's in general studies as well as a master's degree in criminal justice from Lamar.

NOTABLE

- This is the 5th season of BPCCC Lady Cavaliers basketball and the college's 50th Anniversary
- Sophomore guard Ashlyn Jacobs scored a single-game record 43 points versus Blinn
- Jacobs needs just 45 more points to become the school's all-time leading scorer
- Jacobs also set a school record for most field goals made in a game with 15
- Jacobs holds the school record for field goals made in a career with 286
- Ashlyn or "Muff" as she is affectionately known has scored in double figures in all 11 of BPCCC's games
- With its 92-89 overtime loss to Blinn, the Lady Cavs are 4-2 in overtime games in program history
- Freshman guard Monette Bolden scored a career-high 27 points in BPCCC's 90-79 loss to Tyler
- "Mo" as she's known, added five rebounds, two assists and two steals in her best all-around performance as a Lady Cavalier
- Bolden hit a 3-pointer at buzzer to beat San Jacinto 76-73
- BPCCC has lost three straight games for the second time this season
- The Lady Cavs snapped a four-game losing skid with its 79-76 win over Hill earlier in the season
- Last year, BPCCC's longest losing skid was nine games
- Unfortunately, the Lady Cavaliers have lost center Damilola Balogun until January with a wrist injury suffered against San Jacinto
- Balogun was averaging 9.1 points and 5.8 rebounds per game before injury
- With its 90-68 win over Coastal Bend, BPCCC is 2-3 in Region XIV openers
- Sophomore guard Brandy Harris equaled a season-high 15 points against Tyler
- The 90 points scored by the Lady Cavs against Coastal Bend were their highest total of the season and the highest since scoring 99 in a win over Panola on 2/27/15
- The win over Hill was a first in school history
- Up until the Tyler game, forward Tyra Kidd had played well in the previous five games averaging 15 points and 7 rebounds per game
- Kidd had just two points and four turnovers against Tyler
- BPCCC has a 1.1 assist-to-turnover ratio per game
