JOHN RENNIE - HEAD COACH / ATHLETIC DIRECTOR



After finishing 8-21 and missing out on postseason play in 2016-17, coach John Rennie and his team have high hopes for a return to success on the hardwood in 2017-18.

In launching the women's basketball program at BPCC, Rennie has led the Lady Cavaliers to a 55-65 (.458) record through four seasons as a college coach, after coaching most of the previous 20 years as an AAU coach in the Shreveport-Bossier area. His former players include many who advanced to play collegiately as well as two at the WNBA level.

As a player at the now defunct Trinity Heights Christian Academy, Rennie helped lead his high school team to three state championships while earning All-State, All-District and All-City honors.

He is also the founder of HoopKids Basketball, an enrichment program that teaches basic basketball skills to preschoolers while further developing their gross motor skills. Operating this program has allowed him the privilege to watch hundreds of pre-school children grow and develop basic coordination skills while learning about the great game of basketball.

Rennie, who also serves as the Athletic Director at BPCC, resides in Benton, La., with his beautiful wife, Melissa and his children, Caden (14) and Claire (11) Cox.

Rennie's thoughts on the 2016-2017 season:

"We're playing a very difficult schedule again this year," said Lady Cavaliers head coach John Rennie, who begins his fifth season at BPCC. "I looked at the preseason national rankings, and we have three of the top six on our schedule this year, including two-time defending national champion Gulf Coast State, as well as two-time national runner-up and conference opponent Trinity Valley."

"We have the depth to matchup better and compete for 40 minutes this year," said Rennie. "Our sophomores have made a lot of progress over the last year. Then, with the newcomers we have added we feel we should be able to return to the regional tournament. It definitely wasn't enjoyable not playing postseason basketball last year."

ALICE ROBINSON - ASSISTANT COACH



Alice Robinson is in her second year as an assistant coach at Bossier Parish Community College. A Bossier City native, Robinson returns home after spending two seasons as a student assistant coach at Lamar University in Beaumont, Texas.

Robinson played in 63 games over two seasons for the Cardinals from 2012-14, scoring 264 points and grabbing 356 rebounds. She helped lead the Cardinals to the postseason in both years at Lamar, advancing to the second round of the WBI in 2013 and qualifying for the WNIT in 2014.

As a senior, she averaged 3.8 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. Had career highs of 13 points and 13 rebounds against Our Lady of the Lake. Tied her career high with 13 points in a Southland Conference Tournament semifinal game versus Northwestern State. She was named to the Southland Conference Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.

Prior to Lamar, Robinson played two seasons for Trinity Valley Community College. She helped lead the TVCC Cardinals to the NJCAA National Title and an undefeated 36-0 record as a sophomore. Robinson averaged 5.4 points and 7.9 points per game as a sophomore at Trinity Valley.

Robinson played for Aaron Megee at Parkway High School, where she earned honorable mention all-state honors as a senior. Parkway retired her uniform number in 2015. She also competed in track and field in high school, finishing fifth in the state in the shot put as a senior.

She holds an associate's degree from Trinity Valley, a bachelor's in general studies as well as a master's degree in criminal justice from Lamar.

NOTABLE

- This is the fifth season of BPCC Lady Cavaliers basketball and the college's 50th Anniversary
- Sophomore guard Ashlyn Jacobs scored a single-game record 43 points versus Blinn
- Jacobs also set a school record for most field goals made in a game with 15 against Blinn
- Jacobs holds the school record for field goals made in a career with 332
- With her 15 points against New Mexico JC, Jacobs became BPCC's all-time leading scorer. Her two-year total currently stands at 882 points
- Ashlyn or "Muff" as she is affectionately known, has scored in double figures in 17 of BPCC's 19 games this season
- Jacobs' 6 points vs. Paris was her lowest total of the season
- Jacobs' two 3-pointers vs. Jacksonville gave her a school-record 100 for her career
- With its 76-67 overtime win at Paris, the Lady Cavs are now 5-2 in overtime games in program history
- Freshman guard Monette Bolden scored a career-high 30 points in BPCC's 81-74 loss to Jacksonville
- "Mo" as she's known, is averaging 17.7 points, 4.6 rebounds and 3.9 assists per game in Region XIV play
- Bolden scored 23 points and pulled down 6 rebounds versus Paris
- The Lady Cavs had lost three straight games before the win at Paris. BPCC longest losing skid this season is four games
- Center Damilola Balogun returned to the court at Paris. It was her first action since suffering an injury against San Jacinto
- Balogun scored six points and pulled down nine rebounds vs. Paris
- With its 90-68 win over Coastal Bend, BPCC is 2-3 in Region XIV openers
- Sophomore guard Brandy Harris scored a career-high 17 points in the Lady Cavs' win over BRCC
- Harris had a career-high seven assists versus Paris
- The 90 points scored by the Lady Cavs against Coastal Bend were their highest total of the season and the highest since scoring 99 in a win over Panola on 2/27/15
- The win over Hill was a first in school history
- Sophomore forward Tyra Kidd has averaged 10.6 points and six rebounds in the last three games
- Sophomore forward Savannah Thomas scored 18 points and grabbed 11 re-
